





Question 1 - Do you live in the city, suburb or a rural area?










Question 4 - How long do you estimate you could last without electricity before you would experience significant harm to your daily life?






Question 6 - How safe or secure would you feel in your home or neighborhood if an extended power outage (more than 1 week) were to occur?








Question 7 - How prepared do you feel you (and your family) are for an extended (more than one week) power outage?








Question 8 - In the event a power outage lasting more than a week, do you anticipate significant financial or physical damage to yourself or someone you know?






Question 9 - Do you believe the American electric power transmission grid is vulnerable to either cyber or physical attack from enemies of the United States?






Question 10 - Do you believe the federal government should create a public/private partnership to immediately address this potential problem?






Question 11 - Which group is most qualified to find solutions to the strengthen and protect the nation's electric grid? (check all that apply)






Question 12 - What is the maximum surcharge you would be willing to pay on your electric bill to subsidize the work needed to help protect the electric grid?








Question 13 - Do you believe the federal government should use taxpayer funds to further protect the grid?








Question 14 - Do you believe a combination of taxes and a surcharge is the most appropriate way to fund strengthen the grid?








Question 15 - What is your age?






Question 16 - What is your gender?
